## Rehearsal Attendance

Rehearsals will be on Wednesdays from 2:30-3:30 in the Sullivan Music Room (105) unless otherwise noted. Rehearsal attendance is mandatory unless discussed BEFORE rehearsal with Mrs. Boyer. No more than THREE unexcused absences will be accepted. Excused absences include illness, absence from school, a death in the family, or a family emergency. All excused absences must have a written note from the parents turned into Mrs. Boyer. More than three unexcused absences will constitute grounds for removal from Sullivan Chorus. Because of non-attendance days and meetings, we have a very limited amount of time to prepare for our concert. Please do your best to make sure your singer is at each rehearsal!!

* The dress rehearsal on Tuesday, December 12 will take place from 2:30-4:00 in the MacArthur Middle School Gym. PICKUP WILL BE AT MACARTHUR ON THIS DATE. The concert will take place that evening, May 24, at 7:00 PM at MacArthur Middle School. Students need to be at MacArthur by 6:30 PM for warmups. The concert will be combined with Sullivan Band.


## Procedures

On rehearsal days, students will come straight to the music room, place their backpacks against the music wall in the hallway, then go to their assigned choir spots. Once students are in their assigned spot, they should take out their music and do the following: look over pitches, rhythms, words, dynamics, and start memorizing. Students must be in their spots and ready by 2:30!

## Pick-Up Procedures

Students must be picked up in the car rider area (map below) at 3:30. Parents must stay in line and pull up, four cars at a time, as directed by Mrs. Boyer. If students have not been picked up by $3: 35$, phone calls will be made home. If this occurs more than twice, students may be removed from choir. Thank you for your cooperation.
