Play Information

- We will cast approximately 27-30 students

- There are about 10 main roles, and around 7 smaller ensemble roles

- There are also plenty of roles for the ensemble who will sing in the choir and appear together as a group in various scenes. These roles are very important parts of the play

Audition Procedures

-Only students interested in acting must audition (not crew)

- At the audition students will be asked to perform a song of their choice without accompaniment

-They will also be asked to read lines from the script that was sent home

-The script should be memorized. We are looking for students who read with expression, and without relying on the paper

- More readings from the script may be added if necessary- no memorization required

Audition Procedures (cont.)

- At the audition we will look for:
- The ability to sing accurately and on pitch
 Voice projection
- -Effort given to prepare for the audition
- Behavior, responsibility, attitude, and enthusiasm

Audition Procedures (cont.)

-The more flexible a student is with which parts they are willing to play, the higher the likelihood they will receive a part in the play

- We recommend discussing this with your child before auditions

- We respectfully ask that parents are not present for auditions

Audition Times

-Fifth Grade: 11/13

-Fourth Grade: 11/14

-All students should be picked up at MAC at 4:30

Callbacks

- Announcements for callbacks will be on 11/15
- Listed students will be asked to return 11/16
- Information and permission slips for callbacks will go home the 15th.
- Getting listed for callbacks does not mean your student is guaranteed a spot in the show. Not getting called back doesn't mean you child did not make the show.

Attendance Expectations

- The play is a major time commitment

- If your child is part of cast or crew they are required to attend every scheduled rehearsal

- The only exception is if students miss school due to extreme sickness

- No exceptions will be made for appointments, vacations, or the sniffles

What to Expect - The first rehearsal is 11/28

- Changes to rehearsals will go home via e-mail

- Please check the rehearsal schedule to see which days your child is required to attend.

What to Expect

- Students are asked to provide their own costume for the play
- -Students will be required to purchase a practice CD
- Students must attend every rehearsal they are scheduled for
- Attendance is most crucial closest to the performance
- There will be a daytime performance 2/21
- Students need to be available the evenings of 2/22 and 2/23 for performances

Crew

- Fifth grade students are given the opportunity to try out for crew

- Students may try out for the play and sign up for crew (it is assumed acting is their preference)

- Students in the crew will attend approximately two rehearsals a week, and all rehearsals as the performance nears

Crew

- The crew will be led by Mrs. Mkrtschjan, Mrs. Boyer, and Mrs. Espinos
 Positions include student director, props, lights, curtain, photographer, and sound
- Set Design will be led by Mrs. Barr
